

Let's Get Ready to Sudsy

4 Simple Steps to kickstart your Sudsy Challenge!

1. Planning

When will you take on the challenge as a team?

Pick three days that work for your school and put them in the calendar early! Give people as much notice as you can.

2. Register

As you're super organised and have pre-registered, you'll get an email when registrations officially open (before everyone else!). Then you'll be able to register and **create your team** - it takes just a few minutes. Plus don't forget to add a profile pic!

3. Spread the word

Now you've created your team, it's time to get some teammates on board! Use your unique team's URL to send to potential Sudsy Challengers, or even **download your QR Code** from your team dashboard and add it to the poster we've enclosed to get the word out.

Quick tip: It's quick and easy for individuals to join your team - they just hit 'Join' on the team page to create their individual profile and be connected to the team.

4. Start Fundraising

Now it's time to encourage your team to kickstart their individual fundraising efforts. Each person who raises \$48 (which supports 2 people doing it tough with laundry and showers!) receives their very own **Sudsy Challenge t-shirt** to wear for the three days.

This easiest way is for each team member to share their **individual fundraising link** and tell family, friends and network about why they're doing The Sudsy Challenge - you'll be surprised how quickly the donations come in!
